Altar Server Tips:

Be Early! Please show up at least twenty minutes early before you are schedule to serve Mass. Ask Mom and/o to help you with this! Check with the sacristan and the presiding priests. Help the sacristan with setting up for Ma light the candles, etc.

Be Present! If you can not serve, find a substitute. It is rude to simply not show up without either finding a substi calling the parish office. Mom and Dad can help you with this.

Be Inquisitive! Ask either the priest or the sacristan for help if you have questions or are not sure what to do.

Be Neat! Although servers wear albs, it is also appropriate that servers come to church groomed dressed neatly in a way that reflect the “celebration of the sacred mysteries.” Select an alb that goes to the top of the shoes, but has enough clearance to avoid tripping. Dress shoes are preferable. No shoes with laces please!

Be knowledgeable! There are six times the servers are visible: (1) At the opening procession (2) with the words “Let us Pray” at the beginning of Mass, (3) at the Gospel (4) at collection time (5) at the end of Mass with the words “Let us Pray” and (6) at the recessional leaving Mass. The server also rings the bells when the priest elevates both the Body and Blood of Christ at in his hands and in the chalice during the Eucharistic Prayer.

Be Reverent! Bow whenever crossing or approaching the altar. Genuflect at tabernacle. No talking during Mass. Hands folded neatly in prayer position in procession. Hands resting on leg tops during readings.

Be Graceful! The order of the procession is as follows: banners (when present) incense (when used), Cross, cantor (when used), lector, deacon (when present), concelebrating priests (when present) presiding priest. Walk at slow steady pace.

Be Alert! Schedules are done quarterly with an eye on family members being scheduled together. If you need assistance or have questions regarding schedules, call Bridget at St. Paul parish 725-2050
